General Information

Six fields drill-seeded include: Cross, Jefferson, Lonoke, Mississippi, White and Woodruff Counties. Mississippi County was the first furrow irrigated rice (FIR) field to be planted. Pre-emergence herbicides have been applied to all fields. Pre-plant fertilizer applications were made according to soil samples. Should have stand counts next week.
