Issue No. 1

(Popular Name)

A Constitutional Amendment to be Known as "The Citizens Only Voting Amendment" and Providing That Only a Citizen of the United States Meeting the Qualifications of an Elector Under the Arkansas Constitution May Vote in an Election in this State.

(Ballot Title)

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO CREATE "THE CITIZENS ONLY VOTING AMENDMENT"; TO PROVIDE THAT ONLY A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF AN ELECTOR UNDER THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION MAY VOTE IN AN ELECTION IN THIS STATE; AND PROVIDING THAT A PERSON WHO DOES NOT MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF AN ELECTOR UNDER THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOTE IN ANY STATE OR LOCAL ELECTION HELD IN THIS STATE.

Issue No. 2

(Popular Name)

A Constitutional Amendment to Amend Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, § 5, to Protect the Right to Keep and Bear Arms.

(Ballot Title)

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE THAT THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS FOR THEIR COMMON DEFENSE, FOR LAWFUL HUNTING AND RECREATIONAL USE, AND FOR ANY OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSE; PROVIDING THAT THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS INCLUDES WITHOUT LIMITATION THE POSSESSION AND USE OF AMMUNITION, FIREARM ACCESSORIES, AND FIREARM COMPONENTS; AND PROVIDING THAT THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS IS A NATURAL, FUNDAMENTAL, AND INDIVIDUAL RIGHT THAT SHALL NOT BE INFRINGED.

(Popular Name)

A Constitutional Amendment Concerning Economic Development in the State of Arkansas; and Authorizing the General Assembly to Provide for the Creation of Economic Development Districts Within Cities, Counties, or Cooperative Areas to Promote Economic Development Within the Economic Development District.

(Ballot Title)

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE STATE OF ARKANSAS; AND AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS WITHIN CITIES, COUNTIES, OR COOPERATIVE AREAS TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT.

Issue No. 4

(Ballot Title)

Arkansas Water, Waste Disposal, and Pollution Abatement Facilities Financing Act of 2025.

(Ballot Question)

Shall the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission be authorized to issue general obligation bonds under the authority of the Arkansas Water, Waste Disposal, and Pollution Abatement Facilities Financing Act of 2025, for the financing and refinancing of the development of water, waste disposal, water pollution control, abatement and prevention, drainage, irrigation, flood control, and wetlands and aquatic resources projects to serve the citizens of the State of Arkansas, in total principal amount not to exceed five hundred million dollars (\$500,000,000), with no more than one hundred sixty-five million dollars (\$165,000,000) in total principal amount of such bonds to be issued to finance and refinance the development of irrigation facilities, in series from time to time in principal amounts not to exceed, without prior approval of the General Assembly, sixty million dollars (\$60,000,000) in any two-year period beginning on July 1 of each odd-numbered year, which bonds shall be secured by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the State of Arkansas?

OFFICIAL BALLOT

The bonds described below that are approved may be combined into a single issue or may be issued in series from time to time. The City currently has in place a one percent (1.0%) city-wide sales and use tax levied under Ordinance No. 2015-05 adopted by the City Council of the City on June 8, 2015, which was approved by special election of the electors of the City held on August 11, 2015 (the “**2015 Sales and Use Tax**”). No bonds will be issued for any purpose unless each of the Refunding Bonds and the System Improvement Bonds are both approved. If both the Refunding Bonds and the System Improvement Bonds are approved, then there will be levied a replacement 1.0% sales and use tax within the City (the “**Replacement Tax**”), the net collections of which remaining after the State of Arkansas deducts its administrative charges and required rebates, will be used and allocated (a) 7/8 solely to retire the bonds and obligations of the City with respect thereto and shall expire on the last day of the last month of the calendar quarter in which such bonds or any bonds issued in refunding thereof have been retired and (b) 1/8 to the operation and maintenance of the System Improvements and other City facilities and to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds, which portion of the tax will not expire. The Replacement Tax will replace the 2015 Sales and Use Tax. If the Refunding Bonds and the System Improvement Bonds are not both approved, then the 2015 Sales and Use Tax will remain in place along with the City’s currently existing bonding authority with respect to the 2015 Sales and Use Tax. The effective date of the Replacement Sales and Use Tax, if approved, will be the day following the date the existing 2015 Sales and Use Tax expires.

REFUNDING BONDS AND REPLACEMENT TAX

Vote FOR or AGAINST an issue of bonds of the City of Ozark in the maximum principal amount of \$2,825,000 for the purpose of refunding the City's outstanding Sales and Use Tax Bonds, Series 2016, and, in order to pay and secure the bonds, the levy and pledge of a new 1.0% Replacement Tax within the City.

SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT BONDS AND REPLACEMENT TAX

Vote FOR or AGAINST an issue of bonds of the City of Ozark in the maximum principal amount of \$18,000,000 for the purpose of financing betterments, improvements, upgrades, and expansion of the City's water and sewer system facilities and, in order to pay and secure the bonds, the levy and pledge of a new 1.0% Replacement Tax within the City.
