General	<p>By Chris Elkins.</p> <p>Rain continues to be the biggest challenge of the season. Woodruff county received the most rain with 1.9" and Poinsett County received the least amount of rain with .2". Several fields received their first herbicide application this week and have had excellent control. Insect pressure has dropped slightly since the previous week. Disease continues to be minor. Arkansas 1	NK 42T5XF	R2	Received 1.06" rain, should canopy soon, no insect or disease pressure.
Arkansas 2	Pioneer P49Z02E	R1	Received 1.05" rain, excellent growth, applied 1 qt. Glufosinate 280L + 1 qt. glyphosate + 1.25 pts S-metolachlor, good control.
Clay	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	R1	Received 1.1" rain, excellent weed control, no insect or disease pressure.
Craighead	Asgrow AG47FX2	VE	Received 1.13" rain, Planted Asgrow AG47FX2 on 6/4 at 140K, Pre fertilizer 0-50-75, pre-emerge 1.5pts Boundary, stand counts next week.
Jefferson	NK 43-W1XFS	V5	Received 1.11" rain, almost R1, applied 1 qt. Liberty + 1 qt. glyphosate + 1.25 pts S-metolachlor. Good weed control.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	V4	Received .93" rain. should continue to see excellent growth, more rain on the way, will evaluate weed control next week.
Poinsett	Pioneer P48Z70BLX	V2	Received .2" rain, Good growth, good weed control and suppression of nutsedge, deer feeding on edge and small areas of drown out.
Prairie			Field is prepped and ready to plant when weather allows, More rain on way.
White	Pioneer P46A90LX	R4	Received 1.6" rain. Progressing quickly, good canopy, setting several pods, Low insect pressure and disease pressure. Initial Irrigation scheduled for 6/16.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG46XF3	R4	Received 1.9" rain. Good growth, 80% canopy, Early R4, Insect and disease pressure remain low, Initial Irrigation scheduled for 6/16.
