General	By Chris Elkins. Rain was limited this week with Woodruff County receiving the most rain with .75" and three fields receiving no rain. Insect pressure remains low but there is an increase in Stinkbugs, Loopers, and Corn earworms. Frogeye Leaf Spot can be found in most fields but moving slowly. Clay	Asgrow AG49XF4	R5	Received .25" rain, good pod set, 1.5/25 stinkbug, second irrigation 7/24. Third irrigation scheduled for 8/2.
Cross	Asgrow AG47FX2	R4	Received .27" rain, Almost R5, insect and disease pressure low, Initial irrigation 7/24.
Drew	DynaGro S47XF23S	R6	No rain, good pod fill, 3/25 stinkbugs, 7/25 loopers, third irrigation 7/24. Expected final irrigation 8/1.
Jefferson	Delta Grow 48XF70STS	R6	No rain, Almost R6.5, 3/25 Stinkbugs mixed, good moisture will monitor sensors for potential final irrigation.
Lawrence	Progeny 4515XFS	R5	Received .26" rain, R5.2, 2.5/25 Stinkbugs, minor Frogeye Leaf Spot, irrigated 7/27.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R5	Received .12" rain, R5.5, insect and disease pressure remain low, second irrigation 7/22, Third Irrigation scheduled for 7/28.
Phillips	AgriGold G4910XF	R6	No rain, Dryland, Short moisture, needs rain. 4/25 stinkbugs, disease pressure remains low.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG47XF2	R4	Received .2", almost R5, low insect and disease pressure, third irrigation 7/30.
Prairie	UA54I19GT	R2	Received .07" rain, continues to have excellent growth, defoliation pressure increased slightly, second irrigation scheduled for 8/1.
White	Aarmor 48F55S	R6	Received .24" rain, R6.5, field has good moisture and irrigation terminated.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG48XF3	R5	Received .75" rain, R5.5, 4/25 Stinkbug, FLS remains below threshold, third irrigation scheduled for 8/2.
