General	By Chris Elkins. Another week of hot and dry weather. Prairie County received the most rain with .58" and one field received no rain. Stinkbug populations are rising quickly. However, several fields have reached R6 and thresholds have doubled. Seven fields are now done and waiting on harvest. Refer to table below for field specific information.
