



## Arkansas Rice Research Verification Program Weekly Update July 5, 2024 – Update No. 13

## **General Information**

The Jefferson County field is in the heading stage. Fields in the late-boot stage include Cross, Drew, Lonoke, Mississippi, White and Woodruff Counties. The Chicot County field is in the 4<sup>th</sup> tiller stage. The Poinsett County field is in the 2<sup>nd</sup> tiller stage. The irrigation well has been down for 13 days. Report today is that a submersible well is now running. Rainfall has been scarce. Fertilizer is scheduled for Drew, Cross, Lonoke, Mississippi and Woodruff Counties.

Chicot	CLL18 (FIR)	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Fertilizer went out 7/1 urea (100 lbs) + NBPT.
Drew	RT 7521 FP (FIR)	Late-Boot	Late-boot N scheduled urea (70 lbs) + NBPT.
Jefferson	Ozark	Heading	50% heading 7/11.
Lonoke	RT 7521 FP*	Late-Boot	Propiconazole (8 oz) applied 6/25 for smut history. Late-boot N urea (70 lbs) + NBPT scheduled 7/6.
Mississippi	RT 7321 FP* (FIR)	Late-Boot	Poly pipe laid and water flowing. Late-boot N urea (70 lbs) + NBPT scheduled 7/8. Rainfall .55"
Poinsett	Ozark	2 <sup>nd</sup> Tiller	The water started 6/19 irrigation well went down 6/22 with well back up today 7/5. N loss and weed escapes monitored. Rain has been scarce.
White	RT 7521 FP*	Late-Boot	Late-boot N applied 7/2 urea (70 lbs) + NBPT. Sheath blight below threshold.
Woodruff	RT 7521 FP*	Late-Boot	Late-boot N urea (70 lbs) scheduled 7/8. Sheath blight below threshold.
