



## Arkansas Rice Research Verification Program Weekly Update July 26, 2024 – Update No. 16

## **General Information**

Fields at the medium dough stage include Jefferson, Lonoke and White Counties. Fields at the 75 % heading stage include Cross and Drew County. Fields at the early heading stage include Mississippi and Woodruff County. The Chicot and Poinsett County fields are at internode elongation (IE) stage. The Jefferson County field has been sprayed for stink bugs.

Cross	RT 7521 FP*	75% Heading	Stink bugs average 1 per 10 sweeps.
Chicot	CLL18 (FIR)	IE	Mid-season fertilizer applied 7/19 urea (100 lbs) + NBPT.
Drew	RT 7521 FP (FIR)	75% Heading	Stink bugs average 1 per 10 sweeps. Rainfall 1.7"
Jefferson	Ozark	Medium Dough	Tenchu 20 SG (8 oz) did a good job cleaning up stink bugs. Drain date 8/4.
Lonoke	RT 7521 FP*	Medium Dough	Stink bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. The field is clean and uniform.
Mississippi	RT 7321 FP* (FIR)	Early Heading	Late-boot N (70 lbs) urea + NBPT applied 7/8.
Poinsett	Ozark	IE	Disease below threshold level.
White	RT 7521 FP*	Medium Dough	Stink bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. Rainfall 1.90"
Woodruff	RT 7521 FP*	Early Heading	50% Heading date 7/16. Field is behind DD-50.
