General	<p>By Chris Elkins. Several fields received good rains this week with Drew County receiving the most with 1.86” rain and three fields receiving no rain. Stinkbug numbers continue to climb but remain below threshold. Starting to see a few corn earworms in later planted fields. Disease pressure is low in most fields. Refer to table below for field specific information.</p>

Arkansas 1	Pioneer P47A64X	R5	Received 1.5” rain, good pod set, low insect and disease pressure, Fourth Irrigation scheduled for 8/4.
Arkansas 2	Pioneer P48A14E	R5	Received 1.5” rain, great potential, low insect and disease pressure, Fourth Irrigation scheduled for 8/4.
Craighead	NK 49-C2XFS	R3	Received .2” rain. Early R3, < 1/25 corn earworms. Initial irrigation 7/23.
Cross	Virtue 4520S	R6	Received .15” rain, good potential, 4/25 green stinkbugs, third irrigation for 7/20.
Drew	Asgrow AG46X0	R5	Received 1.86” rain. Mid R5, 1/25 green stinkbugs, fifth irrigation scheduled for 8/3.
Jackson	Pioneer P48A14E	R3	Received .15” rain, Late R3, insect and disease pressure remain low, Next irrigation scheduled for 7/24.
Jefferson	Dyna Gro S46XS60	R5	Received .87” rain, Late R5, 3/25 green Stinkbugs, third irrigation 7/23.
Lawrence	Dyna Gro DG46XF31	R5	No rain, good potential, insect and disease pressure remain low, Irrigated 7/23.
Mississippi	Becks 4885XF	R6	Received .76” rain, good potential, 1.5/25 Stinkbugs green, next irrigation scheduled for 7/29.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG45XF3	R3	No rain. insect pressure remains low, slight frog-eye, well issues will irrigate as soon as possible. Several areas stunted from lack of water.
Randolph	Pioneer P52A14SE	R3	Received .50” rain, Late R3, 2.25/25 stinkbugs. Third irrigation scheduled for 7/27.
St. Francis	Pioneer 46A20LX	R4	No rain continues to have excellent growth, <1/25 green stinkbugs and disease pressure remain low, Third irrigation 7/23.
White	Pioneer P48A14E	R3	Received 1.65” rain, slow to canopy in few areas, 1.5/25 corn earworms, Irrigated 7/24.
Yell	Pioneer P48A14E	R2	Received .14” rain, late flush of grass, recommended 1 qt. glyphosate, 1/150 corn earworms and disease pressure remain low.
