



Arkansas Rice Research Verification Program Weekly Update July 25, 2025 – Update No. 15

General Information

The two fields that are at the hard dough stage include Desha and Jefferson Counties. We will keep the water on next week and drain the first week of August. Stink bug numbers have dispersed and averages have gone down since there's more heading rice. Fields at the heading stage or headed stage include Chicot, Crittenden, Lonoke, Prairie and White Counties. The Poinsett County field is at the late boot stage while Woodruff County is in the mid boot stage.

County	Cultivar	Stage	Additional Agronomic Details
Chicot	RT 7421 Silver FP*	100% Heading	Sting bugs averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. The DD-50 drain date is 8/3
Crittenden	DG 263 L ⁺ (FIR)	50% Heading	The field is clean and will sweep for stink bugs at 75% heading. Drain date 8/12. Rain .55"
Desha	RT 7521 FP* (FIR)	Headed Hard Dough	Stink bugs averaging less than 1 per 10 per sweeps. The kernels are 2/3 straw colored. Will water through one more time next week. Drain date 8/3
Jefferson	DG 263 L ⁺	Headed Hard Dough	Stink bugs averaged 1 per 10 sweeps. Heading stage has outrun sheath blight. Positive stops were at 20%. Drain date 8/3.
Lonoke	RT 7521 FP*	100% Heading	The field is clean, uniform with low sheath blight. Stink bugs average 4 per 10 sweeps. Some kernel smut found yet treated weeks ago. Rain .27"
Prairie	RT 7302	75% Heading	The field is clean and below threshold for sheath blight. Stink bugs averaging 3 per 10 sweeps.
Poinsett	CLL18 (FIR)	Late Boot	The field has resistant barnyardgrass escapes along with weedy rice. 50% Heading 7/27. Rain .75"
White	RT 7521 FP*	50-75% Heading	Field is clean with a good flood and low disease. Stink bugs averaging 4 per 10 sweeps in the south part of field at 75% heading. Rain .38"
Woodruff	RT 7421 FP*	Mid Boot	The field is clean and uniform for late rice. Late boot N (65 lbs) scheduled for next week. Rain .28"
