General Information

Rain has stopped the harvest for a couple days but it will soon continue. The fields harvested include Desha and Jefferson Counties. Fields that are mature waiting on harvest include Chicot, Crittenden, Lonoke, Prairie and White Counties. The Poinsett County field has reached threshold for sting bugs but since its past 60% hard dough we have walked away. Woodruff County is in the second week of heading and warranted an insecticide application.
