General	By Chris Elkins. Rain was scattered this week with Poinsett County receiving the most rain with 1.5" and three fields receiving no rain. Insect pressure remains low with a few fields starting to see corn earworms. Frogeye Leaf Spot remains common but well below threshold. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Cross	Asgrow AG47FX2	R3	Received 1.4" rain, late R3, insect and disease pressure low, Initial irrigation scheduled for 7/23.
Drew	DynaGro S47XF23S	R6	No rain, good pod set, 2/25 stinkbugs, third irrigation scheduled for 7/23.
Jefferson	Delta Grow 48XF70STS	R6	No rain, filling pods quickly, 2/25 Stinkbugs mixed, third irrigation 7/21.
Lawrence	Progeny 4515XFS	R5	Received 1.05" rain, R5.2, 1/25 Stinkbugs, disease pressure remain low, irrigation scheduled for 7/24.
Mississippi	Becks 4999XF	R5	Received .6" rain, R5.2, good pod set, low insect and disease pressure remain low, second irrigation scheduled for 7/22.
Phillips	AgriGold G4910XF	R5	No rain, Dryland, Almost R6, Short moisture, insect and disease pressure remains low, needs rain to maximize seed size.
Poinsett	Asgrow AG47XF2	R3	Received 1.5", Good canopy, almost R4, low insect and disease pressure, second irrigation 7/23.
Prairie	UA54I19GT	V11	Received .1" rain, excellent growth, good canopy, 1/75 corn earworms and disease pressure low, second irrigation scheduled for 7/27.
White	Aarmor 48F55S	R6	Received .15" rain, 2/25 stinkbug mixed, low disease pressure, third irrigation 7/20.
Woodruff	Asgrow AG48XF3	R5	Received .7" rain, R5.2, .5/25 Stinkbug, Frogeye Leaf Spot pressure slowly increasing, second irrigation 7/22.
